In connection with the disguise parties and the appearance of comedian groups at the Viennese court, Lodovico Ottavio Burnacini paid a lot of attention in his drawings to the human face and its alienation by means of masks, false noses and chins, make-up and other cosmetic applications. His occasionally rough imagery, full of grotesquely disfigured faces, is reminiscent of the physiognomic studies of some 15th and 16th century artists. But how does his approach relate to the studies of Leonardo da Vinci, Giovanni Battista Della Porta or Charles Le Brun? Did Burnacini simply want to distort reality, address inner states of mind, even character traits, or merely put the facially alienating means of the theatre to the test in order to obtain tragically funny and original figures?
